RECIPE CORNER

CURRIED SHRIMP AND NOODLE SOUP



Serves: 4 - 6 Prep Time: 40 minutes

INGREDIENTS:

- ¼ cup Thai red curry paste
- 4 cups low-sodium chicken broth
- 1 can (13.5 ounces) of coconut milk
- Green (onion) scallions
- 8 ounces of vermicelli rice noodles
- 1 teaspoon grated lime zest and 2 tablespoons fresh juice; plus, wedges for serving
- 2 tablespoons of fish sauce, such as Red Boat
- 1-pound large shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 2 cups shredded napa or savoy cabbage
- Chopped roasted peanuts, for serving

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a medium saucepan, whisk the curry paste over medium heat until fragrant, l minute. Whisk in broth and coconut milk. Add scallions and simmer for 10 minutes.
- 2. Cook noodles in water for about 2 minutes; drain water.
- 3. Add lime zest and juice, and fish sauce. Add shrimp; simmer until just opaque, 2 to 3 minutes. Stir in noodles; cook for one minute. Serve the soup topped with cabbage, scallions, and peanuts. Add lime wedges on the side.
